INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS


NO claims for damages / defects will be recognised after installation.

Prior to installation it is important to unpack and inspect your products to ensure no damage has occurred in transit and that the product IS CORRECT.

If damage has occurred, or a visible defect exists, do not proceed with installation and contact supplier IMMEDIATELY.

Read all instructions beforehand. Pay particular attention to locations of plumbing, brackets and measuring up for these.


- Step 1. A stud wall will be required as outlined below. See figure 1.
- Step 2. Assemble cantilever brackets using fixings supplied. See figure 2.








- **Step 3. a)** A 90mm wall cavity will need to be created to enclose plumbing and mounting frame. See figure 1 for pre-installation set out.
 - b) Fix mounting frame to timber studs with 12 gauge x 2 1/2" coarse thread screws, or similar. Ensure cantilever brackets are plumb and level. See figure 3



- Step 4. a) Connect plug and waste to 'P' or 'S' trap. Tray should be secure.
 - **b)** All plumbing, including water supply and stop taps, should be located under the tray for ease of maintenance and adjustment. See figure 4.




*For disabled toilets, this bracket top dimension is to be determined by subtracting selected Washplane thickness. See Figure 12 from required finished height.
Finished height range is 770-800mm as per AS 1428.01-2001





Step 5. a) Slide drainer into tray. The locating tabs are at the back of the tray which the drainer rests against.


b) The drainer is designed to be removed for cleaning purposes. See figure 5.



Step 6. a) Close and finish wall.

b) It is recommended to consider access to the plumbing behind your finished wall. This can be achieved by incorporating a removable panel between the bracket arms, or under the tray. Depending on your wall finish, consider utilising split lines between tiles to conceal the panel. See figure 6.

- Step 7. a) Adjust screw head to finish in line with the finish wall. See figure 7.
 - b) Use a drop of silicone to attach screw head to inside of fascia, which slides over the horizontal bars or mounting frame. See figure 8.




- Step 8. a) Carefully place Washplane onto the cantilever brackets. Ensure the saddles line up and sit over the arms. See figure 9.
 - **b)** Tighten the grub screws to secure the Washplane. See figure 10.











Step 9. Washplane finishing heights

*NOTE:
The mounting frame is designed to fit into a standard 90mm wall cavity. It is to be fixed between nominal 90 x 45mm hardwood studs

The Washplane has been designed to be installed without the use of excessive silicone. Please refrain from using silicone to assemble any components. Do not silicone around hardware and finished wall tiles.





DETAILED CLEANING INSTRUCTIONS

Regular cleaning will assist to keep your solid surface looking fantastic and reduce wear and dirt build up. Spills should be cleaned promptly.

Clean with a mild detergent or soapy water and a soft cloth, sponge or non scratch scourer*.

For stubborn marks start with the non-scratch scourer and a mild detergent, if required use a diluted very mild abrasive cleaner* cleaning in light circular motions.

Intense clean/repair: For extreme marks and light scratches a very Light buff in circular motions using the finest grade sand/glass paper will restore the surface. A heavier grade of sandpaper will scratch the surface which can be removed by then using a light sand paper. Avoid applying excessive pressure or clean/rub the same area for a prolonged time unless repairing a scratch or damage.

*Always test 'non scratch' and 'mild abrasive' products in a non-conspicuous area first to ensure suitability as brands can differ.

Important notes: If the product is created from a combination of Solid surface and another material such as glass or Softskin, it is important that the cleaning instructions for Solid surface are not carried out on the alternate material. Damage may occur which will void your warranty.

To maintain a uniform appearance, you may need to clean the entire surface. Never use sharp products such as steel wool or aggressive, commercial grade / strong cleaners or chemicals (e.g. acetone, trichloroethylene, acids, and caustic soda) as these may damage and scratch the surface. For best results always finish by wiping surface clean of all detergents and dry with a soft clean cloth.
