Franke Olten Mixer Care Instructions

- Periodically clean the aerator filter
- Install filter valves under the sink and periodically clean the filters
- Do not use detergents, solvents, chemical agents, abrasive sponges, wire wool or alcohol etc. which would irreparably damage the surface of the product and ruin its appearance, sheen and matte finishes.
- Clean with soapy water and dry with a soft cloth
- Dry the product after use if the water is very hard or aggressive, as it may leave deposits, which would damage the surface.
- Do not install the tap when the water pressure exceeds 500kPa (in this case, pressure limiting valves are required).
- Rinse the water pipes before installing the tap
