

Water Supply Requirements

To ensure optimum performance and customer satisfaction please adhere to the following:

- Maximum hot water temperature 75°C.
- Recommended minimum working pressure 150kPa.
- Recommended maximum working pressure 500kPa.

If the water pressure exceeds or is likely to exceed 500kPa, an approved pressure limiting valve must be fitted.

- Flush out all pipe work prior to installation.
- If the water temperature exceeds 75°C an approved tempering valve must be fitted.
- Installation should comply with Australian standard AS3500.1 or relevant local authority requirements.




Guarantee

This product is guaranteed against faulty workmanship and materials for 1 year from the date of purchase. Installation must be done by a licensed plumber or this guarantee will be void.




- 1 Screw the shower mixer assembly in place.

Do not remove the protective cover until final fit-off.




- 2 Attach water supply and water outlet
TEST AND CHECK FOR LEAKS



- 3 Create a 45mm round hole in cement sheet and tiles.

Remove the protective cover. Push on the dress plate.

Push on the mixer handle and tighten with the grub screw.
