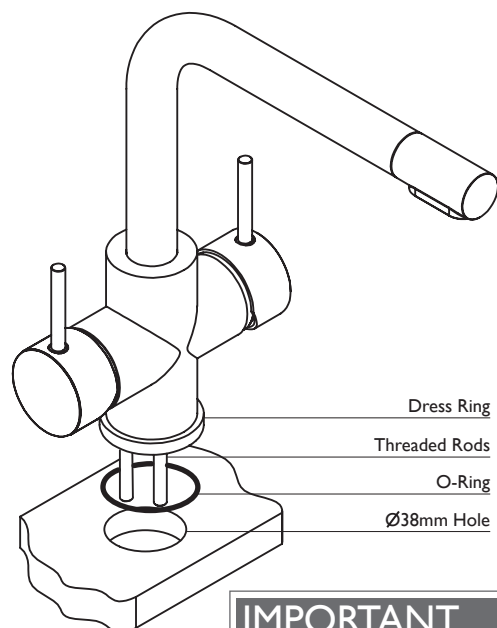

- Using a 38mm hole saw, cut a neat hole through the bench top.
- Screw the Threaded Rods tightly into the base of the Mixer.
- Fit the Dress Ring and O-Ring at the base of the Mixer.
- Place the Mixer over the hole and lower into position.

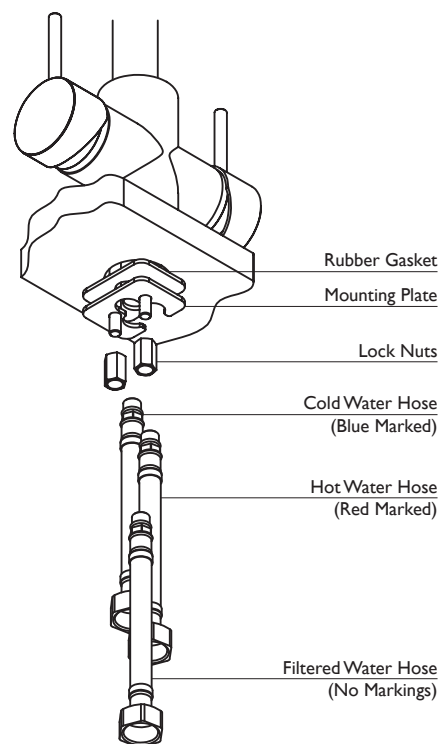


IMPORTANT

This Mixer requires mains HOT and COLD plus an additional COLD water connection for the Filtered Water Cartridge Kit. Ensure Mixer is installed and connected to mains water supply prior to connecting the Filtered Water Cartridge Kit.

- Slide the Rubber Gasket and Mounting Plate over the Threaded Rods.
- Fit the Lock Nuts on each Threaded Rod and firmly tighten using the Spanner provided.
- Connect Filtered Water Hose to mixer first.
- Connect the Hot and Cold Water Hoses to the Mixer and Mains connection.

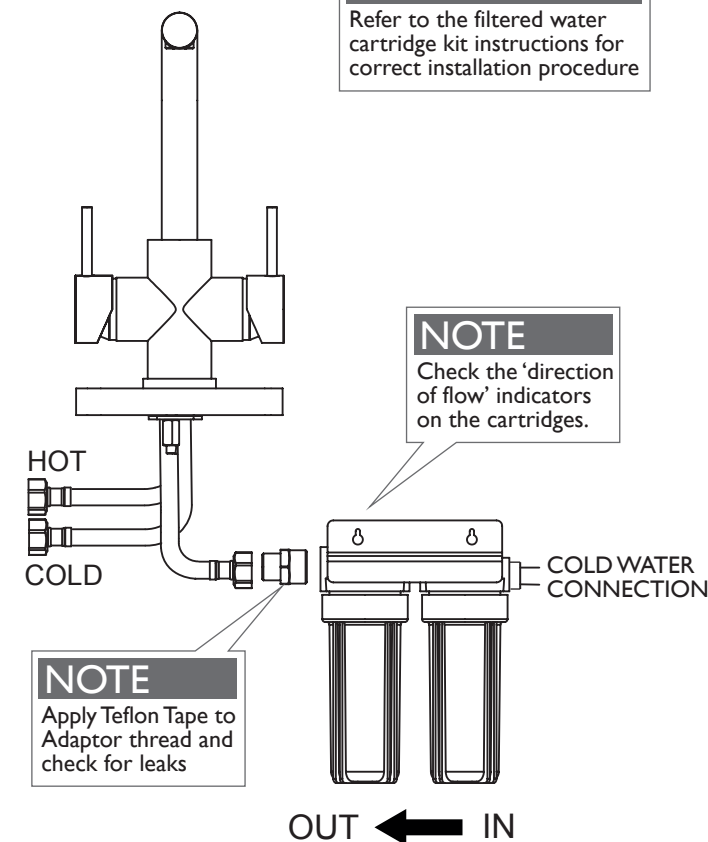

NOTE:

- If the pressure exceeds or is likely to exceed 550kpa, an approved pressure limiting device must be installed.
 - Flush out all pipe work prior to installation.
 - If the water temperature exceeds 75°C, an approved tempering valve must be fitted.
 - Installation should comply with Australian standard AS3500.1 or relevant local authority requirements.
- Showers may not be suitable for use within:
- Gravity-fed water systems
 - Some instantaneous hot water systems; or

- Pressure supply less than 150kPa;

NOTE: The 500kPa maximum water supply pressure does not apply to fire service outlets.

Failure to comply with the above may void all warranties.
