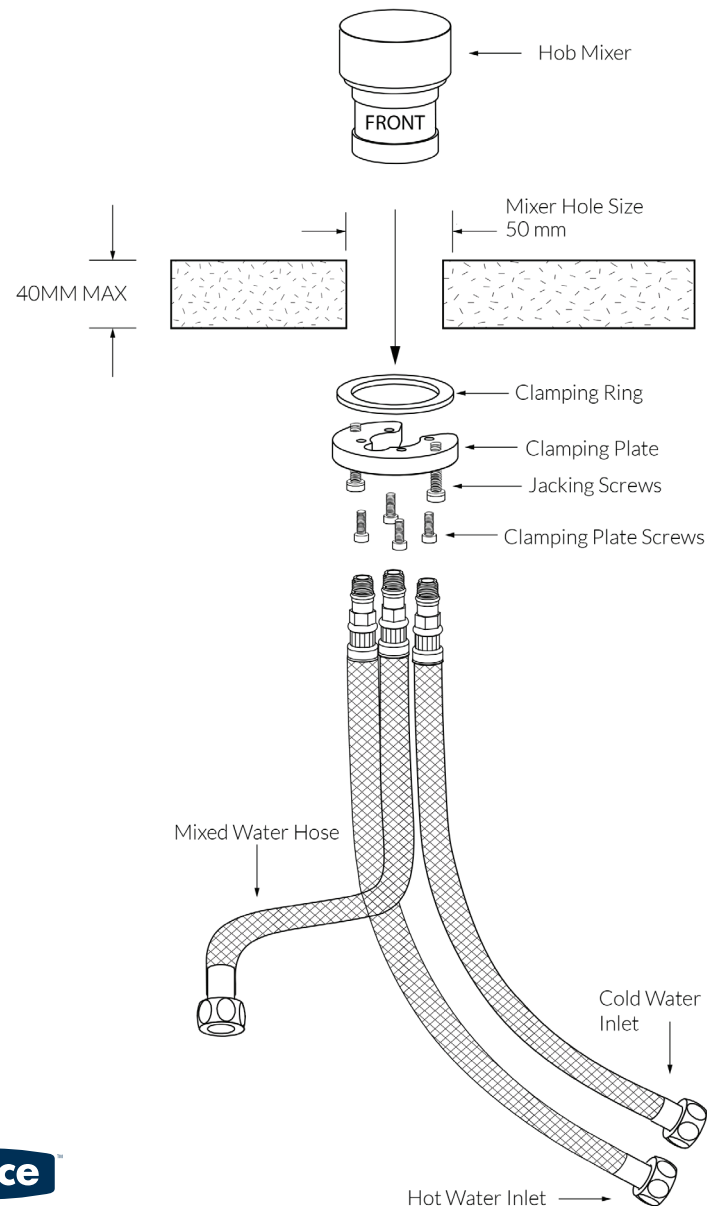


Pure Elemental Sink Progressive Mixer Set Pull Out Spray

Mounting Surface Requirements:

- Outlet: 35mm Clearance Hole.
- Hob Mixer: 48mm - 50mm Clearance Hole.
- Minimum Distance between Outlet and Mixer is 100mm centre to centre.
- Maximum Mounting Surface thickness is 40mm.
- Mounting Surface must be flat and level.
- Ensure adequate space under the bench for the Pull-Out Hose and Weights to sit free from obstruction. Failing to do so will affect the performance of the Pull-Out function.

Hob Mixer (Progressive):

- Prior to installing remove the Clamping Plate and Ring. The Flexible Tails are labelled and are factory fitted, there is no need to remove from Mixer Body.
- Apply a small amount of Sealant to the under side of the Hob Mixer Flange to seal the Mounting Surface.
- Lower the Hob Mixer through the Mounting Surface.

Note: The "FRONT" label must be positioned to face the user.

- Working from underneath, fit the Clamping Ring over the Mixer Body. Align and secure the Clamping Plate to the Mixer Body by tightening the 4 Screws.
- Secure the Mixer to the Mounting Surface by tightening the 2 Jacking Screws using a 5mm Allen Key (tighten well).
- Fix the Hot and Cold Hoses to 1/2" BSP Water Connections.

Note: Stop Cocks are recommended.

- Attach the "MIXED WATER HOSE" to the DCV.
- Once all connections are made allow Water Flow and check function of the mixer. Check for leaks.

Plumbers note:

Tapware is to be installed by a Licenced Plumber in accordance with AS/NZS 3500:2025

Recommended working water pressure 300-500kpa.

Maximum water temperature is 65 deg.C.
